**FREDDIE MAC ANNOUNCES STRUCTURED PASS-THROUGH
CERTIFICATES SERIES T-029 REDEMPTIONS**

McLean, VA - Freddie Mac announced today that it would redeem the following Structured Pass-Through Certificates on the dates specified below with payments made to holders of record on the dates specified below. The Sponsor of the Underlying Trust has notified Freddie Mac that it will exercise its optional redemption right causing the redemption of the Structured Pass-Through Certificates. Freddie Mac will pass through to the Holders of each Class of Certificates the outstanding principal amount of its related Underlying Class, plus accrued and unpaid interest thereon. Payment of the principal amount of the Structured Pass-Through Certificates, together with interest accrued on such principal amount for the Interest Accrual Period relating to the applicable payment date, shall be made to the holders of the Structured Pass-Through Certificates on the books and records of the Depository Trust Company as of the close of business on the record date below.
