<sup>1</sup> In 2002, Freddie Mac entered into an agreement with the Community Foundation for the National Capital Region ("Community Foundation"), which established the Freddie Mac Community Relations Donor Assisted Fund ("DAF"). Freddie Mac funded the DAF by making a one-time irrevocable gift to the Community Foundation in 2003. The Community Foundation authorizes distributions from the DAF, although Freddie Mac can, and does, make recommendations for such distributions. These investments support nonprofits that create and preserve affordable housing, help prevent foreclosures, and strengthen communities.
