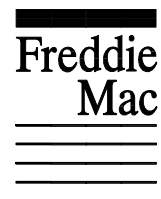

Redemption Date(s): On August 25, 2006 only
Interest Rate: The Medium-Term Notes bear interest at different fixed rates, during different periods. (See "Step Interest Rates" herein.)
Frequency of Interest Payments: Semiannually, in arrears, commencing August 25, 2004
Interest Payment Dates: February 25 and August 25
Principal Payment: At maturity, or upon redemption
