This Pricing Supplement relates to the Debt Securities of the Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation ("Freddie Mac") described below and should be read in conjunction with the Offering Circular dated June 29, 2005 and all documents incorporated by reference in the Offering Circular including Freddie Mac's Information Statement dated June 14, 2005 and any supplements to such Information Statement. Capitalized terms used in this Pricing Supplement and not otherwise defined in this Pricing Supplement have the meanings given to them in the Offering Circular.

The Notes have the same terms (other than Issue Date and issue price) as, and form a single series with, the 5.05% Notes Due December 8, 2008 that Freddie Mac issued in the principal amount of US \$500,000,000 on December 8, 2005 and December 14, 2005. The aggregate principal amount of the 5.05% Notes Due December 8, 2008, including the Notes issued pursuant to this Pricing Supplement, will be US \$1,250,000,000. See "Description of the Debt Securities - General - Reopened Issues" and "- Maturity, Redemption and Optional Repayment" in the Offering Circular. Interest on the Notes offered pursuant to this Pricing Supplement will accrue from and including December 8, 2005.

The Debt Securities are not suitable investments for all investors. In particular, no investor should purchase the Debt Securities unless the investor understands and is able to bear the redemption, yield, market and liquidity risks associated with the Debt Securities.
