INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING FORM 1036DC

DESIGNATED COUNSEL:

- Freddie Mac loan # -- provide the nine loan number digits for the Mortgage.
- Borrower name -- provide the Borrower's first, middle and last name.
- Property address (street, city and state) -- provide the physical address of the property securing the Mortgage.
- Servicer loan # -- provide if it is available to you.
- Check to indicate the reason for the request and whether you require originals or copies.
- Servicer for the Mortgage should provide you with the name and contact information for the Document Custodian holding the Note and associated documents.
- Fax or e-mail a pdf of the completed Form 1036DC, signed by an attorney, to the Document Custodian.
- You must follow prudent business practices in protecting and safeguarding all Freddie Mac documents released to you while those documents are in your possession.
- When your need for the original Note and documents no longer exists, please return them, together with a copy of this Form 1036DC, directly to the Document Custodian and notify the Servicer of their return. Copies need not be returned, but should be destroyed in a manner consistent with preserving confidentiality of Borrower information.

DOCUMENT CUSTODIAN:

- You must verify that the firm identifying itself on Form 1036DC is in fact Freddie Mac's Designated Counsel using the list (formerly Guide Ex. 79) appearing on the website at: http://www.freddiemac.com/service/msp/desig_counsel.html, or by calling (800) FREDDIE.
- If there are discrepancies in the information provided for a Mortgage, such as the Borrower name not corresponding to the loan number, or if the information provided seems incorrect, contact the Servicer or Freddie Mac's Settlement Operations at "fmmdm@freddiemac.com".
- Fax or e-mail a copy of the Form 1036DC that accompanies any documents released to Designated Counsel to the Servicer indicated on the form. You are responsible for obtaining 'in transit' insurance coverage for the documents released to Designated Counsel.
- Retain the Form 1036DC as required by the Form 1035 Custodial Agreement.

SERVICER: This form is for your information only, it does not require any action on your part; however, you may be charged a release fee and delivery expenses with respect to documents that the Document Custodian releases to Designated Counsel.
